# PLENARY LECTURERS ALOPS 23

*PhD Biljana Zekavica*



Completed her PhD studies at the Faculty of Political Sciences of the University of Belgrade. Acting Assistant Minister in the Directorate for Social Protection of the Ministry of Labour, Employment, Veteran, and Social Policy. A member of the negotiating group of the Government of the Republic of Serbia on Chapter 19 of European legislation. Engaged in social policy and employment, within the framework of negotiations for EU accession, in charge of social policy. A member of the Council for Vocational Education and Adult Education, the Council for the Advancement of Intergenerational Cooperation and Solidarity, and the Council for Aging of the Government of the Republic of Serbia.

Associate professor and the chair of the Department of Social Work at the Faculty of Political Sciences in Banja Luka. Planning social development and studying social problems are two of his main areas of interest. He is the author and co-author of several books, scientific papers, and professional studies on the topics of social, family, and child protection: planning social protection for the elderly, managing social protection in crisis situations, poverty and social exclusion, policies in the field of disability, domestic violence, social work in schools, etc. He was a long-time assistant minister for social, family, and child protection in the Government of the Republic of Srpska.

His areas of scientific interest are computer statistics, probability theory, multivariate analysis, biostatistics, simulation models, and business analytics.

*Prof. Vesna **Mijatović Jovin**, PhD*



Vesna Mijatović Jovin, MD, and a Ph.D. in medical sciences, currently works as an associate professor at the Department of Pharmacology, Toxicology, and Clinical Pharmacology of the Faculty of Medicine, University of Novi Sad, Serbia. She participated in six national scientific projects as a researcher in the fields of pharmacokinetics, assessment of the toxicity and safety of the drugs used and other xenobiotics used, psychopharmacology (research of the psychotropic effects of drugs and herbal drugs in animal models), pharmacovigilance (drug side effects, interactions, interactions with herbal drugs), toxicology (toxicity of drugs, analytical methods of detection of drugs or poisons in biological samples), clinical toxicology (elimination of alcohol, acute poisoning with (non) legal psychoactive substances, implementation of rapid toxicological screening tests), and pharmacoepidemiology (drug consumption). She has published 40 research papers in peer-reviewed journals and 20 book chapters.

One author can submit a maximum of two papers, with the fact that in only one he or she can be the first author. Authors may submit an abstract or the paper as a whole. Abstracts and full manuscripts should be prepared according to the Instructions for authors that are attached to this call and sent to the e-mail address: [alops22@asp.edu.rs](mailto:alops22@asp.edu.rs). All submitted abstracts and full papers will be subject to a double anonymous revision. Accepted abstracts will be published in the Book of Abstracts, and accepted full papers will be published in the Proceedings book.

## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS**

Original scientific papers, review papers, and professional papers that have not been previously published or presented at other meetings will be exhibited at the Conference.

One author can submit a maximum of two papers, while the same author can be the first author on only one paper. Authors may submit an abstract or the full manuscript.

## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR ABSTRACT PREPARATION**

- Original scientific papers and review papers should contain a structured abstract with prominent headings for the following sections: Introduction, Aims, Methods, Results, and Conclusion.
- The abstract is written in Latin script in Serbian (Croatian) and in English, or only in English if the paper is written in English.
- The abstract should have between 200 and 300 words.
- Font size: 12 pt.
- Abbreviations and references should not be mentioned in the abstract.
- When displaying the results, state the values obtained by statistical processing.
- At the end of the abstract, three to five key words should be listed in italics, font size 12 pt.

## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR FULL MANUSCRIPT PREPARATION**

The paper should be written in the word processor Microsoft Word (.doc format), in Times New Roman font, in Latin script in Serbian (Croatian) or English, on an A4 page, with margins of 2 cm, with both sides aligned, with a spacing of 1.5 between rows.

### **Title**

- The title should clearly indicate the content of the paper and be up to 200 characters long including spaces; written in capital letters, emphasized (bold), font size 14 pt.
- Avoid abbreviations and subtitles in the title.
- Information on the name and number of the project and sources of financing should be provided in a footnote.

### **Authors**

- Full name and affiliation of all authors; written in font size 12 pt.
- Underline the name of the first author and state his/her e-mail address in the footnote.

### **Manuscript text**

- The paper should contain up to 30,000 characters (including spaces).
- Papers should contain the following sections: Abstract, Introduction, Theoretical approach to the problem, Methods, Results, Discussion (separately or within the results), Conclusion and Literature.
- Text of the paper (font size 12 pt).
- Subheadings within the text (emphasized (bold), font size 12 pt).

### **Tables and graphs**

- The same data should not be presented both tabularly and graphically.
- Tables and graphs should be made in Microsoft Office Word (without vertical lines), and illustrations (pictures and drawings) in JPG format
- Tables and graphs are marked with Arabic numerals in the order in which they appear in the text.
- Tables should be centered.
- The serial number is written in normal, and the names in italics, namely: for tables and graphs above, and for pictures below.
- All text entries should be capitalized.
- Titles in the header and all entries should be written centered, except for entries in the far-left column, which should be align left.
- Symbols and abbreviations should be explained in the legend below the table/graph.
- Tables, graphs and images from other sources may be reproduced only with the permission of the publisher.
- The titles of tables and graphs should be in 12 pt font size, and the content of the tables should be in 10 pt font size, single spacing.

### **In-text references**

The used literature is cited in the text according to APA7 standards as follows:

- if referring to a source with one or two authors, their surnames and the year of publication are always mentioned (Hendron & Kearney, 1999; Ristić and Medenica, 2019; Ristić, 2013; Homana, 2005);
- in case the surnames of the authors are listed outside the parentheses, i.e. within the sentence, then only the year is written in parentheses. For example: As Ristić and Medenica (2019) consider...;
- if the surnames of foreign authors are listed outside the brackets, they must be transcribed (only for papers in Serbian/Croatian), while inside the brackets their surnames must be listed in the original, e.g.: ...u svom istraživanju Hendron i Kernij su došli do sledećih zaključaka (Hendron & Kearney, 1999);
- each quotation (literal citation of parts of the text) should be marked with quotation marks and followed by information about the page number from which the quotation was taken (Johnson & Johnson, 1993: 25; Jovanović et al., 2020: 39);
- if referring to a source that has three or more authors, only the last name of the first author is mentioned with the accompanying mark "et al." or "i sar." for papers in Serbian/Croatian, within parentheses, i.e. "and associates" within the sentence; eg: In the work of Hue and associates (Hue et al., 2004);
- if two authors have the same last name, the first letter of the name should be added in front of each: (A. Rimmel, 2006; M. Rimmel, 2011; B. Jović, 2018; T. Jović, 2020);
- if several works by the same author published in one year are cited, the works should be marked with the letters: (2020a, 2020b);
- if the reference has no author, the name of the institution and the year are stated: (OECD, 2020);
- when citing multiple references, the order is established according to alphabetical order, and the sources are separated by the punctuation mark semicolon, e.g. Bujubasic, 2008; Minic, 2014; Ristić, 2010. A larger number of references by the same author are listed chronologically, from oldest to newest.

### **References in the bibliography**

All references mentioned in the text should be listed in the bibliography and vice versa. References in the bibliography at the end of the paper should be cited in accordance with APA7 standards, font size 12 pt. If a DOI number is available for reference, it is necessary to provide this information as well (e.g., <https://doi.org/10.2298/VSP160426283J>). Below is a description and examples of citing common sources.
